

# 97<sup>th</sup> GA Legislation Passed

## HB1426 AGING-OLDER ADULT SERVCS-RPTS

6/29/11-Sent to the  
Governor

Subject to the availability of funding, the Department must develop and maintain an inventory of aging services. No fiscal impact.

## HB1485 DHS-CROSS AGENCY AGREEMENTS

6/10/11-Sent to Governor

Provides that IDoA, DCFS, DHS, HFS, and DPH shall collaboratively adopt joint rules to establish a cross-agency prequalification process for providers. A cross-agency master service agreement of standard terms and conditions. A cross-agency common service taxonomy for human service providers to streamline the processes. No fiscal impact.

**Department initiative**

**Repeals the Community Senior Services and Resources Act. Relieves adverse audit findings from this unfunded mandate. No fiscal impact.**

**HB2020**

**ELDER ABUSE&NEGLECT-  
DEFINITION**

**6/15/11-Sent to the Governor**

**Department initiative**

**By changing the definition of "domestic living situation" this will allow the Department to continue an abuse investigation even after the victim has been removed from the home and placed in a nursing home/residential facility. No fiscal impact.**

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**HB2043**

**SENIOR  
PHARMACEUTICAL  
ASSIST**

**7/14/11-Signed as  
Public Act 97-0128**

Department initiative

This would change the quarterly mandated meeting of the Senior Pharmaceutical Assistance Review Committee to be "as deemed necessary" by the call of the two co-chairs. Further changes the reporting mandate to be "as deemed as necessary."  
No fiscal impact.

**SB1802**

**HCA 2-IL CARES RX  
CHANGES**

**6/29/11-Sent to the  
Governor**

Amends the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act. As of September 1, 2011, requires beneficiaries of the Illinois Seniors and Disabled Drug Coverage Program to have a maximum household income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.
